#### **Current Regulation Proposals**

- Appellation Regulations
  - Establishes a process by which licensed cultivators can establish appellations of origin.
  - ▶ Just finished second 15-day comment period on 4/12/2021.
  - Next step: Submit final package to OAL
- OCal (Comparable Organic) Regulations
  - Establishes a comparable organic program for cannabis and cannabis products.
  - Regulations have not been finalized, but modeled very closely on the Federal and State Organic Programs.
  - ▶ The term "organic" cannot be used to market, advertise, etc. cannabis

#### Past and Current Legislation of Interest

- SB 67 (2020) Amended Appellation of Origin statute to include a City of Origin designation and clarify which cultivation types could create an Appellation of Origin.
- AB 1525 (2020) Allowed disclosure of licensee information to financial institutions.
- SB 59 (2021) Extending Provisional License Authority to 2028 and extends CEQA exemption for local jurisdictions.
- SB 398 (2021) Pathway to state licensure for prohibited local jurisdictions.
