












## Exhibits & Local Rule 2:10.1.(2)(a-b)

- "Exhibits comprised of several pages of financial data must have a summary page that explains what is hoped to be proved by the exhibit."
  - When seeking to introduce hundreds of pages of documents to provide completeness of record, limit the documents to be admitted to the relevant pages.
- "(b) The parties must stipulate to the foundation for business records of health care providers, financial institutions, school records and expert reports unless there is a valid reason to question their authenticity."
