

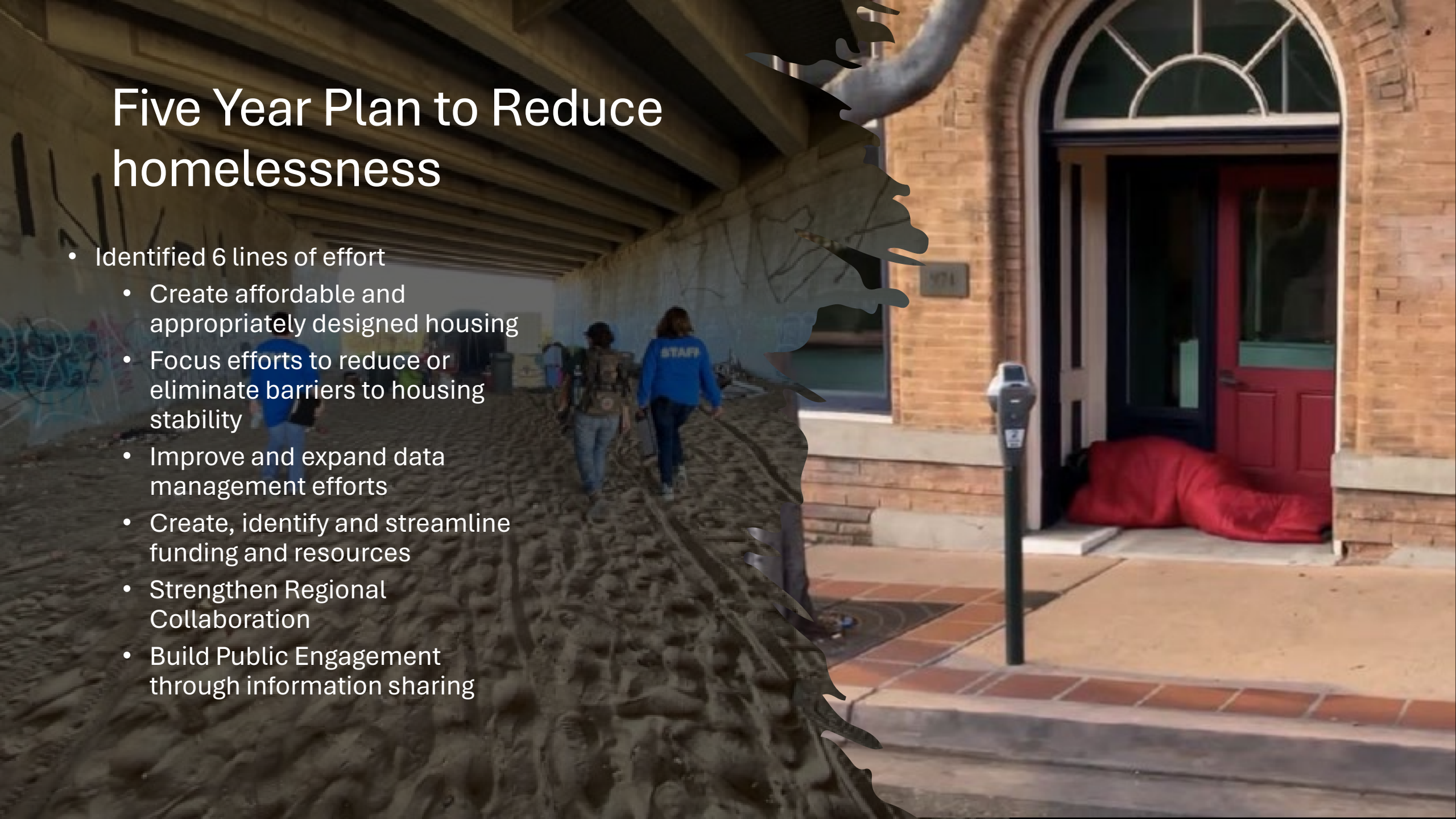

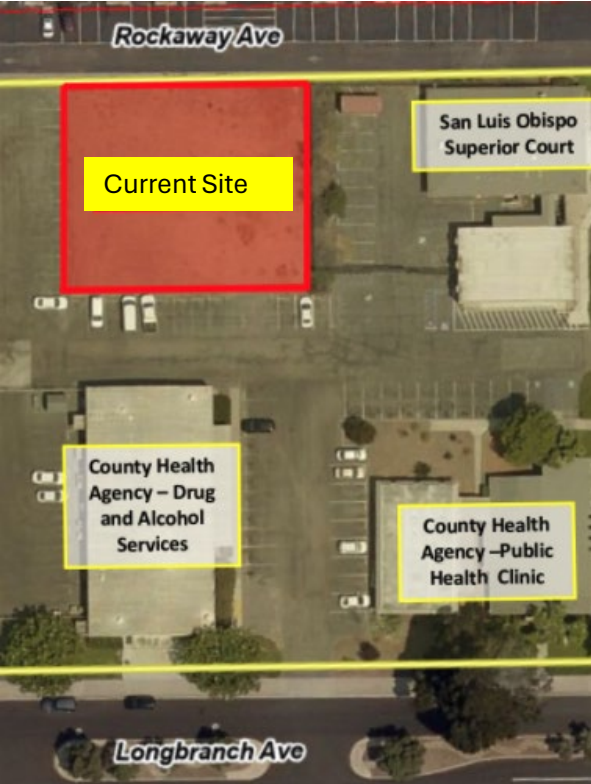

- Went live 3/4/24
- Onboarded 9 separate agencies to utilize one central system
- 373 Help Desk request for assistance received in just the first month
- Daily office hours for two weeks post go-live
- Weekly newsletter
- Online 'knowledge base' created
- Online training modules developed
