




Delay in Processing of Judgments

Do not contact the Department Clerks regarding status of judgments. They are not involved in processing of judgments.

It is not helpful to contact the Processing Clerks regarding status of judgments. You are taking tim away from their processing of files.

No Remote Court Reporting

Government Code § 69959 [Effective January 1, 2023]

- (a) Remote court reporting shall not be used by courts to make the record of any court proceedings, and courts shall not expend any funds to purchase equipment or software to facilitate the use of remote court reporting.

 (b) Temote court reporting' means the use of a stenographic reporter who is not present in the courtroom to produce a verbatim record of court proceedings that are transmitted by audiovisual means to the reporter.


"Any parent who is represented pro-bono, on any type of government assistance, or has been deemed indigent by the courts is entitled to a free account, no questions asked."



"I just received written notice from Thomson Reuters that effective March 31, 2025 the Disso Master and the DissoMaster Suite (i.e. Propertizer and Executioner) will be discontinued. In the coming days, could you please find out if the count will be subscribing to another similar software subscription or will something new to used as a readeacompa(2.7 Finds you."

"As I understand from an email I received from the Ventura Court, Ventura is trying out CalSupport, Family Law Software, Family SofSupport Cale, and X-spouse. If any of you have any experiences with any of these, can you let me know? My intention is to provide feedback to the court, whether they ask for it or not."

SLO FL Bench has not yet determined which alternative to the Dissomaster Suite would be used by the court.

It does not appear that CalSupport or FamilySoft SupportCal offer a property division program. Family Law Software and Xspouse each offer a property division program, which will be necessary programs.

"My understanding is if a request for a DVRO is filed after 2 p.m. on a given day, it will be considered the following day. Is that correct?

I have been asked by the clerk's office to delay filing a DVRO request until a case number is assigned to a Petition for Dissolution, which can take 24 hours. Since there is already a built-in delay based on the above, should such a request be made by the clerk's office? "

Any Request for DVRO received after 2:00 PM will be reviewed by

If you file a Request for DVRO together with a Petition, then both will be filed under the same case number. While the DVRO will be given priority in processing, there may be some delay as to the processing of the Petition due to the backlog of documents.



What costs for county-pay minor's counsel cases need to be approved in advance? (for example, witness fees, fees for subpoenaed records, costs required by CWS, payments required by health care professionals for consultation with minors' counsel, deposition costs, transcript costs, etc) and what is the procedure for requesting them (which recognizes the additional cost to all if an RFO to get the cost approved needs to be filed)? Is there a set dollar amount above which minors' counsel should request permission to incur the cost?

Costs:

- All of them no matter what the dollar amount.
- Ask on the record at the first appearance after appointment if you can.
- No need for an RFO, but not sure at this time what vehicle to use.
